ABOUT US

ACTS is a non-profit organization addressing the academic, social and spiritual needs of the elementary children of Springfield through tutoring and mentoring.

- Focused on reading, writing and math skills.
- Students referred by teachers and parents.
- In addition to snack time and tutoring time, Club Time is a voluntary segment that deals with spiritual and moral issues, and Judeo-Christian values.

As a group, we read Bible stories and discuss the choices faced by the characters. Students also learn to value the diversity of people and cultures. Similar to our focus basic academic skills, Club Time focuses on basic Bible literacy.



WHO WE SERVE

ACTS has served the children of Springfield for more than 30 years, offering FREE one-to-one tutoring and mentoring.

We currently serve about 75 Springfield elementary school students at 10 sites around the city. Each child is matched with a volunteer tutor who mentors and tutors the student under the guidance of a Site Director. The Site Director and tutor develop lessons and activities to meet each child's learning needs.
